



Standards of Behavior

In order to create a great experience for everyone, the following standards of behavior will be observed by all participants. Violation of any of the follow may result in your being sent home- at your expense.

- Respect one another's opinions. Each person has an equal contribution to the team.
- Respect each other's personal space - keep your hands to yourself.
- Respect each other's personal property – stay out of others stuff.
- Be considerate of every team member. Bullying or intimidation in any manner is not acceptable.
- Use positive and encouraging language. Cursing is not an acceptable form of communication.
- Respect wildlife and the environment. Practice Leave No Trace Outdoor Ethics.
- Your staff and adult team members are giving their time for you- respect, listen to, and follow their directions.
- The possession or use of alcohol, drugs (except prescribed medications disclosed on your health form) and tobacco is not permitted.
- Leave knives, hatchets, saws or other sharp tools at home.
- Firearms or fireworks of any kind are not allowed.
- When walking along cliff edges, maintain two body lengths from the edge.
- Swimming in waters above waist deep is only allowed when a lifeguard is present.
- Dress appropriately. Modest attire creates a comfortable non-distracting environment for everyone.
- When involved in water activities such as boating, canoeing or whitewater rafting a properly fitted life vest MUST be worn at all times.
- When riding in a Camptown vehicle, each person must wear a seatbelt and remain seated at all times. All body parts must be kept inside the vehicle. The noise level should be such as to not distract the driver. There should be no throwing of objects or other disruptive behavior. Loading and unloading of the vehicle will be done only after the Program Leader gives any special instructions or expectations after the vehicle comes to a complete stop.

I have read and understand the expected standards of behavior. I understand that if I do not follow these standards I can be sent home at my cost. In the event of a dispute regarding my behavior, I understand that the Camptown Staff has the final authority.
